THOMAS TROPHY

Competition Notes

1. The Trophy is a qualifying medal competition, played off the white tees, using Competitive club handicaps. Putt out, names in the computer.
2. To qualify for the competition and associated prizes, players must have participated in at least six Highwaymen Roll-ups or Matches in the preceding twelve months.
3. The competition is played in late July or early August.
4. The Start Sheet is in handicap order - low to high – in groups of 3balls.
5. The current entry fee is £5 and is payable on the day of the competition.
6. Late entries can only be accepted at the discretion of the Committee.
7. The Trophy will be awarded to the player with the best net score over 18 holes. Prizes are also awarded for 2nd, 3rd and 4th place.
8. Other prizes will be awarded as follows: -

Best gross score over 18 holes
Best net score over front nine
Best net score over back nine.
9. Individual hole awards
 - a. 6th - Ball nearest the flag in one shot, ball must be on the green to qualify.
 - b. 8th - Ball nearest the flag in two shots, ball must be on the green to qualify.
 - c. 13th - Ball nearest the 200-yard fairway marker plaque in one shot in any direction. The ball must be on the fairway to qualify.
 - d. 14th - Ball nearest the flag in one shot, ball must be on the green to qualify.
 - e. 15th - Longest drive, ball must be on the fairway to qualify.The Pro-Shop puts out the necessary hardware on each hole, which should be brought in by the last group out.
10. All prizes will be awarded at the Highwaymen's Xmas Dinner.
No player can win more than one prize under categories 7 and 8.
