

What are Highwaymen Handicaps?

The purpose of HWM Handicaps is to spread the Thursday morning HWM rollup prize money across as many HWM as possible throughout the year.

The main point to note is that your HWM Handicap **ONLY** applies to **HWM Thursday morning rollups** that are **INDIVIDUAL** competitions (eg Eclectic Stableford, Elliott Cup etc). So for any HWM **team or pairs** Thursday morning rollup (eg Texas Scramble, Stableford Pairs etc) then you use your CONGU handicap. For any HWM knock out competition or HWM Inter Club match – use your CONGU handicap. Obviously HWM handicaps are not to be used in any Club golf event.

A/ For HWM Thursday morning **INDIVIDUAL** rollups there will be two sets of results:

1. “For the glory” – these will be the top four scores based on **CONGU handicaps**
2. “For the money” – the top four scores based on **HWM Handicaps**
 - The Winner, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place will win prize money AND they also have their HWM Handicaps cut by 3, 2, 1 & 1 respectively.

B/ For HWM Thursday morning **Pairs or Team rollups** there will only be one set of results (based on CONGU handicaps) and there are no handicap cuts applied to the winners.

Notes:

1. HWM Handicaps are reset back to CONGU handicaps twice a year (on 1st April & 1st November)
2. Please remember, if it's an individual HWM rollup, score your card using your HWM handicap (entering your strokes onto HC Master will create the “for the glory” results).
3. For Trophy events (Balgarnie Cup, Serenyi Salver, Kim Short, Thomas Trophy), your CONGU handicap is used to determine the Trophy winner and the HWM hc is used to determine who gets the rollup money.
