You are provided with personal liability insurance because of the England Golf affiliation fees within your subscriptions paid via WGML.

As an individual member you are covered for personal liability in the event that you are found to be negligent for causing injury to another person or damage to third party property whilst playing or practising golf at any golf club or recognised practice facility in the UK, Channel Islands, or the Isle of Man.

The England Golf policy provides:

- £10,000,000 Public liability for third party injury.
- £10,000,000 Public liability for third party property damage.

There is no excess in respect of personal injury claims, and just a £500 excess in respect of damage to third party property.

## **Exclusions**

You are not covered for: -

- Golf equipment accidental damage, theft or loss, including whilst unattended at a golf club.
- New for Old golf equipment cover.
- Personal accident cover with no upper age limit.
- Supplementary Personal Liability to include the USA and Canada.
- Hole in One cover.
- Hospitalisation.
- Loss of club subscriptions.

Your own personal household and contents insurance may cover some or all of these – so check! Otherwise, Bluefin can provide the cover for an additional premium.
